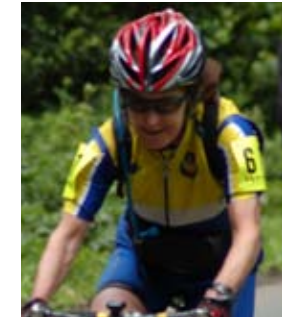

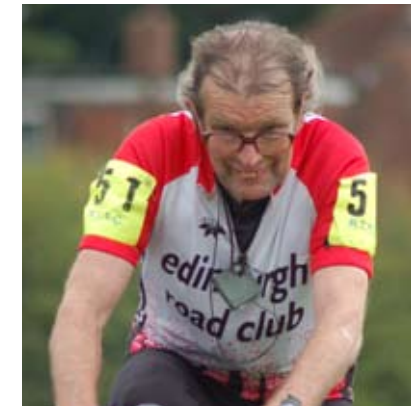

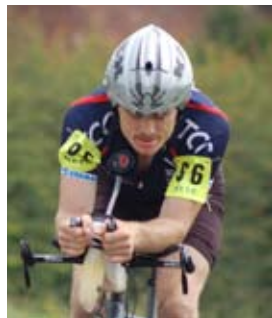

## THE ORGANISER'S VIEWPOINT

In 1946 when the East Sussex Cycling Association was formed, time trials were private and confidential, riders wore black alpaca jackets and black tights when they raced and anyone over 30 who competed was regarded as an oddity. Time triallists rose in the dark and rode out to the start of an event, rolled their possessions in their capes and tucked the bundle under a hedge. There was no 24 Hour National Champion in that year as the Championship did not appear on the calendar until 1948. The national record was 444.75 miles and had been set in 1935.

The Fellowship operates two long distance time trialling competitions. These are for anyone who completes one 100 mile, 12 hour and a 24 hour C.T.T. recognised event. There is one based purely on average speed and the other is for Veteran's and uses the V.T.T.A standards to calculate the best plus mph for the three distances.

The Fellowship also produces a journal twice a year containing articles, competitions, photographs, race reports and many other items of interest to long-distance cyclists. The annual subscription rates are:
